- 1. The Tournament is sanctioned by the ITF, approved by Tennis Seniors Australia and shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the game adopted by the ITF Rules of Tennis and Regulations for the Conduct of Seniors Tournaments, the ITF Seniors Circuit Code of Conduct, Tennis Australia's Member Protection By-Law and National Extreme Weather Policy and Tennis Seniors Australia Regulations. In respect of any disagreements or disputes with regard to the interpretation and implementation of these rules and regulations, the final decision will rest with the Tournament Referee in consultation with the Tournament Director.
- 2. The Tournament is entirely under the management of the Tennis Seniors Victoria Incorporated, which reserves the right to make any changes to the conduct of the Tournament it considers necessary.
- 3. No complaints in connection with the tournament can be entertained by the Tournament Committee unless made in writing and lodged with the Tournament Director within 48 hours of the occurrence of the cause, and any application for leave to appeal against any decision of the Tournament Committee can be entertained by the TSA within ten days after receipt of such decision by the complainant.
- 4. Group 4 & Group 5 non ITF Doubles entries and the Sunday welcome social doubles event and the Dinner can be made via this entry form or online by closing date of Wednesday 18th November 2015. Entry for the welcome social doubles event on 22nd November may be taken via sign on the day but is subject to availability.
- 5. Payment for all events is during online entry OR via this entry form and, together with the signed Player Agreement and Release form, should be sent either by mail to Rob Hughes, The Treasurer TSV, 5 Deanswood Close, Wantirna South, VIC 3152 or scanned and emailed to <a href="mailto:rshughes@optusnet.com.au">rshughes@optusnet.com.au</a> No entries will be accepted by telephone or facsimile. No refunds will be given once draws have been published. No player will be placed in a draw without payment of fees.
- 6. Entry Fees: Non-ITF doubles Group 4 events are \$10.00 per player and Group 5 events are \$5.00 per player per event
- 7. All competitors must be over the age specified for events entered as at 31st December 2015. All competitors are encouraged to be registered members of a recognised Seniors Tennis State Association.
- 8. The tournament is open to all International players.
- 9. Doubles competitors are encouraged to enter with partners for the Group 4 events. Players entering nominating as partner required, shall accept the partner allocated by the Tournament Director, however this does not impose any obligation on the Tournament Director to find a partner. For Group 5 events, players enter individually, are graded individually and placed in a round robin group determined by the Tournament Director.
- 10. The Tournament Director will play the Group 4 and 5 events as a Round Robin and/or combine events with a lower age group to play as a Round Robin event.
- 11. All matches will be using the playing format quoted in the ITF Regulations or otherwise determined by the Tournament Referee and Tournament Director if matches are adjusted due to weather or scheduling.
- 12. The Tournament Referee, in consultation with the Tournament Director, will discuss any dispute in respect to the Rules of Tennis, Tournament Regulations, the Code of Conduct, Dress Regulations and in respect to court conditions and weather. If any match is postponed or discontinued owing to the state of the weather, injury or condition of court surface, it shall be resumed from the point at which it was stopped, at such time and place as determined by the Tournament Referee and Tournament Director.
- 13. Regulation tennis attire must be worn at all times during play. Cross trainers, jogging shoes and other non-regulation shoes are strictly prohibited.
- 14. It is recommended that all players be current registered players of an affiliated Tennis Association, Club or Centre. Application forms are available from Tennis Victoria on +61 3 8420 8420 or <a href="https://www.tennis.com.au/vic">www.tennis.com.au/vic</a>. International players are also recommended to have this insurance to participate in the tournament. Please provide your player registration number in the space provided on the entry form
- 15. Withdrawals should be made in writing to the Tournament Director. Any withdrawal after the draw is published may attract an administrative fee.
- 16. The draws will be displayed at the Yarrawonga Lawn Tennis Club on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2015 and will be on the Tournaments website <a href="http://tournaments.tennis.com.au">http://tournaments.tennis.com.au</a>
- 17. Tennis Australia approved tennis balls will be used for the tournament.
