

JUNIOR ATHLETE OF YEAR – MALE

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be 18 years and under at the end of the award period
- Must be an Australian citizen

The Nomination Process for Australian Tennis Awards

- The winners of the State Award for Male/Female Junior Athlete of the Year (or equivalent) will become the nominee for the National Award for Male/Female Junior Athlete of the Year
- If a state/territory does not have an award in this category, the MA may nominate a candidate from that state/territory through the online portal, provided the nominee meets all the eligibility criteria
- The national body reserves the right to enter wildcards for this award.

Selection Criteria

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominees:

- Commendable ranking level and results (ATP/WTA/ITF/AR)
- Demonstrated record playing for Australia (if applicable)
- Appropriate and commendable attitude in-line with the Tennis Australia values and vision:
Collaboration, Excellence, Humility & Imagination
- Compliance with all rules, national policies, and conduct standards set by Tennis Australia
