

MOST OUTSTANDING 30+ TENNIS MASTER

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Be registered (player) with Tennis Australia.

The Nomination Process for Australian Tennis Award

- The winners of the State/Territory (MA) Award for Most Outstanding 30+ Tennis Master (or equivalent) will become the nominee for the National Award for Most Outstanding 30+ Tennis Master.
- If an MA does not have an award in this category, the MA may nominate a candidate from that state/territory through the online portal, provided the nominee meets all the eligibility criteria.

Selection Criteria

The selection panel will give consideration to the following in assessing and comparing nominations:

- Outstanding achievements in relation to 30+ Tennis Masters during the award period.
- Assistance in raising the public profile of 30+ Tennis Masters through demonstrated excellence in playing performance.
- Demonstration of a high level of integrity in all circumstances, on and off the court.
