- ✓ Singles Main Draw: 10 15 December
 - ✓ Eight Round Robin pools with four players in each pool. The top player in each round robin pool advances to the Championship Draw for playoff positions 1 to 8
 - ✓ Best of two (2) tie-break sets & 10-point match tie-break for Round Robin pool matches
 - ✓ Best of three (3) tie-break sets for the Championship Draw
- ✓ Singles Playoff for Positions: 13 15 December
 - ✓ The 2nd players in each round robin pool advance to the playoff positions 9 to 16 stage.
 - ✓ The 3rd players in each round robin pool advance to the playoff positions 17 to 24 stage.
 - ✓ The 4th players in each round robin pool advance to the playoff positions 25 to 32 stage
 - ✓ Best of two (2) tie-break sets & 10-point match tie-break
- ✓ Doubles Main Draw: 10 15 December
 - ✓ Knockout draw, no match play
 - ✓ Best of two (2) tie-break sets & 10-point match tie-break. No-Ad scoring will be used.

This year the December Showdown tournament control will be in a portable container located behind court 7 facing the MCA & Court 2.


PLEASE NOTE: We <u>will not</u> have access to the MCA under croft area like previous years.

VENUE SAFETY

- ✓ Please be aware that Melbourne Park will be in heavy construction mode during the December Showdown in preparation for the Australian Open 2024
- ✓ We ask all people coming onsite to take care when moving around Melbourne Park
- ✓ Always adhere to the signage around the Precinct
- ✓ If you see anything that does not look safe around the Precinct, please report it to Tournament Control immediately





CAR PARKING

- ✓ We are encouraging all players, parents & coaches to utilise the public transport services available to and from Melbourne Park.
- ✓ The best drop-off and pick-up points are outside John Cain Arena on Olympic Boulevard.
- ✓ If you need to drive, car parking is subject to availability in the multi-level Eastern car park. You can access this via Entrance D off Olympic Boulevard.
- ✓ Be sure to turn right at the round-a-bout as there is no access if you turn left due to the AO Site build.
- ✓ Cost for "Non-Event" days is \$7.50 but will increase to \$30.00 per day when major events are held within the precinct.
- ✓ You can pre-book a car park on major event days for \$20.00 via the <u>prebooking link</u>.





PUBLIC TRANSPORT

DOUBLES PARTNER NOMINATIONS

- ✓ Doubles is compulsory for all players accepted into the Australian Junior Tour Masters
- ✓ There will be <u>NO onsite sign-in</u> for doubles.
- ✓ Players must nominate via email <u>decembershowdown@tennis.com.au</u> their doubles partner
 - ✓ Noting that both players need to send through confirmation for the pairing to be confirmed
- ✓ Both nominations MUST be received prior to 12:00noon on Friday 08 December.
- ✓ Players not nominating a doubles partner will be allocated a partner as per the <u>2023 Australian Competitive Play Junior</u> Regulations





CHAIR UMPIRES

- ✓ Tennis Australia will be aiming to employ Chair Umpires and Lines People for all 12U main draw matches at the December Showdown
- ✓ Whilst we will endeavour to have Chair Umpires for all 12U
 main draw matches, there may be some matches during
 the tournament that will be played without a Chair Umpire
- ✓ Court Supervisors will be monitoring any courts that are not allocated a Chair Umpire
- ✓ Please be aware of the specific procedures for matches played without a Chair Umpire via the following link





MATCH PROCEDURES

- ✓ Check in at Tournament Control before your match
- ✓ Matches will be called directly to court.
- ✓ Chair Umpires will meet players on court for the match.
- ✓ PLAY THE MATCH
- ✓ Chair Umpire will collect tennis balls and report the score to Tournament Control
- ✓ Reminder to players to update the scoreboards on the court fence at the change of ends





ORDER OF PLAY

- ✓ Each age group will be allocated a select number of courts to complete their matches each day.
- ✓ Schedule will be presented in a court grid format, so you will follow matches on the court allocated
- ✓ However, be aware that court changes can occur throughout the day, so if leaving the venue for any reason, please check at Tournament Control to ensure no changes to the schedule are being made.





TENNIS BALLS

- ✓ 2024 Dunlop Australian Open Official Ball
- ✓ Main Draw events will have 4 new balls at the start of each match, with a ball change for the third set if required
 - ✓ Chair Umpires will control the distribution of tennis balls





TENNIS ATTIRE

- ✓ Please be sure to review the <u>Tennis Australia Dress code</u> before taking to the court
- ✓ As part of the education process of competing at an Australian Championships there might be some flexibility on the first day, but not for any following days





CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

- ✓ The Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour: Competitive Play will be in use during this tournament
 - 1. Code Violation first offence Warning
 - 2. Code violation second offence Point Penalty
 - 3. Code violation third offence Game Penalty
 - 4. Any subsequent offences Game Penalty or Match Default
- ✓ Please show respect to your fellow competitors, tournament staff, officials and court service personnel. You are responsible for your own actions.
- ✓ If you are unfamiliar with the <u>Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour: Competitive Play</u> please review it before taking to the court





SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS

- ✓ Awards will be presented to players throughout the tournament that showcase the values of Compete, Commit and Respect.
- ✓ Recipients will be announced throughout and at the completion of the tournament.
- ✓ Nominations will be submitted by tournament officials or staff.
- ✓ If you see a player showcase the values of Compete, Commit and Respect, please bring this to the attention of the Tournament Staff.

- ✓ Tennis Lab will be providing restringing services
- ✓ Location will change, please be aware
 - ✓ 10 15 December POP UP service located behind court 5
- ✓ Operating Hours are 8:30am to 4:00pm each day
 - ✓ Estimated turnaround time is 6 hours
 - ✓ Racquets dropped off after 2pm will be ready the following day





PRACTICE COURTS

- ✓ There will be limited practice courts available at Melbourne Park during the December Showdown
- ✓ We will have limited access to practice courts at Albert Reserve during the tournament.
- ✓ Resurfacing of the National Tennis Centre during week two of the December Showdown will be 11 16 December
- ✓ All practice bookings must be made through Tournament Control
 - ✓ Bookings will only be taken for the following day after 5pm when the schedule has been released.





MATCH FOOTAGE

- ✓ The Tennis Australia Performance Team will be recording matches at the December Showdown
- ✓ To gain access to the match footage, parents must activate a Swing Vision account.
- ✓ As a one-off gesture on the part of Swing Vision, they have offered a one-time only USD50 reduction in the pro subscription which will now stand at USD100

MEDIA / PUBLIC RELATIONS

- ✓ Tennis Australia media and public relations staff will also be on-site throughout the tournament and may ask you to participate in stories for the website or social media channels.
- ✓ This may occur after your match or any other time during the tournament.
- ✓ Don't forget to use #DecemberShowdown when promoting on your own social media channels throughout the tournament.





SPORTS PHYSIOTHERAPISTS

- ✓ Will be located at the National Tennis Centre (NTC) in the classroom
 - ✓ For access enter the indoor court enclosure and the door is immediately to your left.
- ✓ Priority Order during the tournament is as follows:
 - 1. Players with upcoming matches
 - 2. Players still in the tournament, but not playing
 - 3. Players out of the tournament
- ✓ The Physio team will be onsite one hour before play starts and up to 30 minutes after play finishes
- ✓ A roving Physio will be located at the Western courts while matches are in progress, their priority will be court calls only
