Match Format:	AMT & JT Main Draw Singles: Best of three (3) tie-break sets AMT & JT Consolation Singles: Best of two (2) tie-break sets and match tie-break (first to 10 points with a margin of two) in lieu of a third set AMT & JT Doubles: Best of two (2) tie-break sets and a match tie-break (first to 10 points with a margin of two) in lieu of a third set. No-Ad scoring will be used JDS Singles & Doubles: Dependant on ball used. <i>Red:</i> First to 10 points, round robin. <i>Orange:</i> First to 4 games, tie-break at 3-all (first to 5 points with a margin of 2 points). <i>Green:</i> First to 6 games, standard tie-break at 6-all. Players will be sorted into groups appropriate to their abilities.						
Junior Tour Main Draw Singles Playoffs:	It is <u>mandatory</u> in all Junior Tour main draws for a playoff match to be played between the losing semi-finalists for third place.						
AMT Bronze Consolation:	Athletes losing in either the first or second round (depending on entries) are reminded that they are required to SIGN-IN to compete in the consolation event. Sign-in will close five (5) minutes after the last singles match.						
Junior Tour Main Draw Singles Consolation:	Participation in consolation events is <u>compulsory</u> for all Junior Tour age groups: 16 Main Draw: Players losing in the 1 st round only are eligible for the consolation. 32 Main Draw: Players losing in the 1 st & 2 nd rounds are eligible for the consolation.						
AMT & Junior Tour Main Draw Doubles:	Athletes must nominate a doubles partner via the on-line entry process. If athletes do not nominate a partner before the final acceptance list is published, the Tournament Director will pair you up with the next highest ranked un-partnered player.
