## Brisbane International Schools' Challenge

The Brisbane International Schools Challenge is a mixed team competition for Queensland primary schools. Each school has the opportunity to nominate one or more teams at Regional ties throughout Queensland. Winners at each tie are then invited to compete at the State final to be held at Brisbane International 2016.

#### **Teams**

Each team must consist of four to five players. Teams can be made up of a mixture of boys and girls or can be solely boys or girls. Players can only enter in either the orange or the green ball competition. Each player is guaranteed to play an equal amount of tennis at each Regional event.

All teams must play in school uniforms, with hats being compsulsory for participation. Each school also needs to submit a team name that they will use for the duration of the event.

#### Cost

Teams must pay a fee of \$15 (incl. GST) per player to participate in the Regional ties. No additional cost will be incurred for participation at the State Final.

#### **State Final**

The winners and runner-ups from all regional ties qualify for the State Final of the green ball event. For the orange ball, all winners of the regional ties qualify for the State Final.

The State Final will be held from 7-10 January 2016 at the Queensland Tennis Centre (QTC) during the Brisbane International. Players must be available for all days of competition, however a reserve may be called in the case of injury/withdrawal if needed.



While the event is based at the QTC, there may be instances where some matches are required to be played at another venue due to scheduling or weather concerns. The orange ball event will be held on Friday, 8 January at the QTC.

The opening ceremony will be held on the evening of Wednesday 6 January 2016 and all players and team managers need to be available for this presentation. All players, the team manager and a parent of each child will be issued accreditation for the duration of the State Final – this will provide access to the grounds at the event but not to seats in the Pat Rafter Arena. #### **Software**

All ties will be run using the new Tennis Australia competition software. Players will be able to access their results online and through the new individualised players app as long as they have entered their details and have been provided with a unique identification number.

#### **Invitational Teams**

Students also have the opportunity to nominate as an individual to be selected in invitational teams to compete in the State Final. To be considered for a place on the team please send an email to tournamentsqld@tennis.com.au. Nominations will close for all invitational teams on Friday October 30. Players will be notified of the outcome of their nomination by Friday 6 November.

#### **Competition & Court Size**

#### **Orange event (Grade 5 and below)**

Children use 50% compression orange balls and play on regular courts with reduced 10.29 m length 6.4 m width.

#### **Green event (Grade 6 and below)**

Children play on a full-sized court using 75% compression green balls.







#### **Format**

Teams play 4 singles and two doubles rubbers. Each rubber will be played as a FAST4 set:

- first to 4 games
- tie-breaker at 3 games all
- no ad-scoring
- play lets

Rubbers will be timed at 20-30 minutes. If the set is completed before time is up play will continue. However, only the completed first set will be considered for the final result.

In both the Orange and Green Ball events, players must serve their first serve overarm; however, if they choose, they may serve their second serve underarm and may also choose to let the ball bounce before hitting the serve (ie. bounce underarm feed as 2nd serve).
