HOST RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Payment of the Hosting Fee to Tennis SA in accordance with the Agreement (minimum contribution of \$2000 or value in kind as detailed in the agreement).
2. Provide a minimum of 2 courts for the duration of the Event.
3. All courts to be in good, clean condition for the Event.
4. All courts to have centre court straps, singles sticks and player chairs.
5. Appoint volunteers or helpers to support the Event.
6. Operations area for staff (to cater for a minimum of six staff at the venue) for the period commencing from 12:00 noon the day prior to the Event and concluding the day after the conclusion of the Event. Operations area to have power.
7. Current / working Defibrillator and first aid kit at main venue.
8. Separate changing areas for female and male players with toilets.
9. Remove any signage on courts as agreed and approved by Tennis SA for the duration of the Event.
10. Provide temporary seating / chairs for spectators.
11. Provide appropriate waste management (general & recyclable) relevant to participant numbers.
12. Provide the venue (or work with Tennis SA to arrange a venue) for a welcome dinner on the Friday night prior the Event for all participants at a per participant cost approved by Tennis SA.
13. Provide catering for staff, players, and spectators for duration of the Event.
14. Provide Tennis SA with access to the Venue from Bump In date until Bump Out date.
15. Comply with all reasonable directions given by Tennis SA in relation to the Event and Tennis SA's policies and procedures.
16. All necessary permits, consents, licenses and authorisations that are required or will be required will be fully operative and in full force and effect during the event.
17. The venue and any other location at which the Event is held is fit and safe for the purpose of use for the Event.
