



TENNIS VICTORIA LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

The Tennis Victoria League Championships provides an opportunity for teams who have won their association section to play off against other association premiership teams across the State and claim the ultimate title of State Champions. This competition is for every association premier, as we grade teams into sections of similar ability so everyone has an incredible weekend of high-quality tennis.

Event Structure

In 2025, all matches will be played on 12 and 13 April at venues across Melbourne. Teams can expect to play at least three matches, with rounds starting early Saturday morning and finals commencing Sunday afternoon.

There will be two separate competitions in 2025 - an open gender competition and a women's-only competition. Women's only teams are welcome to enter the open gender competition as well. Stronger women's-only teams are encouraged to enter the open competition for competition-evenness reasons.

There will be no limit on number of teams registering. It is strongly recommended to book refundable accommodation.

There will be a social function celebrating all participating teams during the weekend at a central location and time to be determined.

Match Format

Each match will be a doubles-only format, with each rubber consisting of an 8-game set (tie-break at 7-7). Each match will see a team of four players compete against another team of four players and will consist of the following sets: 1&2 v 1&2, 3&4 v 3&4, 1&3 v 1&3, and 2&4 v 2&4.

Locations

The League Championships will be played at venues across Melbourne. We will attempt to have teams based at one venue for the weekend, but these venues will vary in location and will not be assigned until all teams have registered and grading has been completed.

Eligibility

Entry is open to all open-age Association Premiership teams who have won their Section between the qualifying period of 1 April 2024 to 29 March 2025. If the Premiership team chooses not to participate, the runner-up team would be eligible to apply to participate.

Participating players must have played at least three times during the Premiership season.

If your team won your Association Section Premiership, but fewer than four and at least two eligible players are available for the TV League Championships, you may find other players to participate providing they have:

- Competed at least three times within the same association within the 12 month qualifying period
- AND have a lower doubles UTR than the average doubles UTR of the players on the premiership team at the time of registration.

Registration

The cost of registration per team is \$200. A minimum of 4 players and a maximum of eight can be named in



your team. Payment is required at time of registration by all teams. All players must have a Competitive Player Profile (CPP). [Click HERE](#) for a support guide if you require assistance setting up your profile.

Team captains will register their whole team through the online form, and will need each player's Tennis ID (6633 number from Match Centre – each player will need to give the team captain this number) as well as confirmation that each player has linked their Match Centre profile to their UTR (a CPP). Registrations will close on Monday 31 March 2025 at 9:00 AM. Early registration is encouraged to avoid disappointment.
