

SERVICE TO TENNIS AWARD

The Service to Tennis Award recognises a person who has personified the essence of leadership, passion, sportsmanship, goodwill and dedication to the sport while making a major contribution to the stature of tennis for over 10 years.

Selection Criteria

Nominees must show that they:

- Have been involved in tennis for a period of **over 10 years**
- Have made a considerable contribution to the sport over a prolonged period of time
- Personify the essence of leadership, passion for tennis, sportsmanship and dedication
- Are highly regarded within the tennis community and have fostered relationships within and between the club/association and the community
- Have made a considerable contribution to the sport, specifically in the area of delivering more active players
- Have performed various roles within the club/association
- Have demonstrated significant achievement while in the roles held within the club/association
- Have provided documentary evidence to substantiate meeting the selection criteria, such as letters of thanks, supporting evidence from current administrators of the club/association, publications depicting the nominee's position within the club/association.

Members are encouraged to nominate colleagues. Nominees may self-nominate or be nominated by another person (note: if you self-nominate you will require a seconder to support your nomination).

All entries must provide the following media to support their submission:

- Three (3) high-resolution photos (in RAW format or TIFF/JPEG in highest file size possible)

Selection Process

Only information provided by the nominee with their online nomination form will be considered by the selection panel. Nominees should attach any relevant additional information with their online nomination form.

All decisions in relation to the **Service to Tennis** award including any questions in relation to eligibility) will be determined by the selection panel in its absolute discretion. All decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Any matters which arise and which are not covered in this document will be determined by the selection panel in consultation with Tennis West Management.

Timeline

- Nominations open – Friday, 20 July 2018
- Nominations close – Friday, 31 August 2018
- Nominations are valid for the 2017/18 tennis season
- The WA Tennis Industry Awards Night will be held on Friday, 12 October 2018

Requirements of Award Recipients

Successful recipients will be required to fulfil the following:

- Participate in marketing and promotional activities in the 12 months following the award
- Prepare an article for the Australian Tennis Magazine. Tennis Australia will provide editorial assistance.

Nomination Submission

Nominations will be accepted **online only** and should be submitted to Tennis West by clicking [here](#) or by copying this link into a browser window: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2018watennisindustryawards>.

Nominations should include:

- Executive Summary (approximately 200 words) – briefly summarise the key points of the Nomination Report.
- Nomination Report (no more than three A4 typed pages, minimum of 10 point font) – this should address all Selection Criteria for the award.
- Supporting Documents, if applicable (maximum of three pages) – as relevant to the award, e.g. letter of endorsement, posters/flyers, program information.
- Supporting Photographs, if applicable (minimum of three high resolution photos).

Nominations are due by 5pm Friday, 31 August 2018.
